<u>Public Comment:</u> No members of the public were present.

Authority Financing Update:

Messrs.' Christopher Gibbons, Kevin Scott, and Howard Woods, were in attendance to present the Board with an updated plan for future financing needs of the Authority. Discussion ensued on several planned capital projects, including the County Line Water Transmission Line, Forest Park Surge Tank, Blue Bell Water Tank replacement, and sewer line repairs, with several different options for financing these projects. Mr. Woods gave a presentation on the methods that could be used to maintain our current financial standing including our bond rating, debt service coverage ratio, the BRIF balance needed to cover six months of operations, and the continued desire of the Board to minimize all future water rate increases.

Mr. Gibbons of Concord Public Finance presented to the Board with several options for financing the above referenced projects, and lengthy discussion ensued regarding the impact of each, and best long-term solution. Upon a motion by member Tenney, seconded by member Sanders the board agreed to implement the recommendation of the Consultants and professional staff, calling for two separate financings. One borrowing will be completed within calendar year 2012 in an amount not to exceed \$10 million dollars in order to take full advantage of bank-qualified rates, with the \$14 million dollar remainder to be settled in early 2013.

Mr. Kevin Scott of Fox Rothschild advised the Board that in his opinion, this financial plan was in proper form and would be supported by bond Counsel.

Mr. Gibbons then reviewed two options for financing the split financing. The Authority could do a bank loan and a bond, or issue two bonds. It was determined that there would be considerable savings to the Authority to use a bank loan for the first borrowing, and a conventional bond issuance for the second borrowing. Upon a motion by member Mengel, seconded by member Tenney the Board authorized Mr. Gibbons to solicit formal proposals to various banking institutions and to authorize the staff and professionals to prepare the proper resolutions and documentation for board approval, based upon the best combination of rates and financing costs. These documents will be presented to the Board for their final review and approval at a later date
